

GISBORNE SECONDARY SCHOOLS SPORTS RELEASE POLICY

This policy applies to the following Gisborne Secondary Schools: Champion College, Gisborne Boys' High School, Gisborne Girl's High School, Lytton High School, Te Karaka Area School.

- 1 Each of the named schools wishes to see genuine sports talent given every opportunity to develop to its fullest and believes that students playing sport for their school is the best way to achieve this as well as being beneficial for the collective good of sport, the students and the school.
- 2 All students must play sport for their own school.
- 3 Where trials for teams are held by the school all students wishing to play sport must enter these trials and give of their best.
- 4 When a school does not field a team at a level of competition that a talented sports student could be a regular member of, the school may release that student, if they request it, to play for a club team.

GISBORNE SECONDARY SCHOOLS GROUP RELEASE POLICY

This policy applies to the following Gisborne Secondary Schools: Champion College, Gisborne Boys' High School, Gisborne Girls' High School, Lytton High School and Te Karaka Area School.

1. Each of the named schools wishes to see genuine artistic talent given every opportunity to develop to its fullest and believes that students performing for their school is the best way to achieve this as well as being beneficial for the collective good of arts, the students and the school.
- 2 All students must perform for their own school.
- 3 Where the school offers an opportunity to participate in an artistic event the student must perform for the school.
4. When the school does not offer an opportunity to participate in an artistic event the school may release that student, if they request it, to perform for an out of school group.
5. The release to participate for another group must be signed off by the Head of the appropriate department and the Principal.
