

## QUEST TRUST.

QUEST ENTERPRISE TRUST resulted from Anne Pardoe (Transition Teacher at GGHS) attending a School to Work Conference in 1987. From these beginnings a Charitable Trust was formed with four teachers and four parents appointed as trustees.

At the time the government was offering to fund ACCESS TRAINING Programmes which could be used to transition students from school to work, along with assisting the long-term unemployed.

Quest Trust was formed with objectives, two of which are:

- “organise educational opportunities for advancing job skills and social and cultural awareness”
- “improve employment prospects primarily in the East Cape area in New Zealand”.

Courses included Life Skills, Spinning and Weaving, Wool Handling, Child Care and Mechanics.

The environment for training for school leavers changed over time and the Trust disestablished its Private Training Establishment (PTE) in 1996.

Since then the funds have been invested and the Trust has been in a position to offer Scholarships, Grants, Book Prizes and a donation to the Girls High Library.

The intention is that QUEST TRUST will continue in perpetuity.
