Dear Parents, Caregivers and students of Gisborne Girls' High School and the Tairawhiti Services Academy.

Kia ora koutou e nga matua me nga tauira o Turanga Wahine, o Te Tairawhiti Services Academy hoki.

Welcome to all students and their whanau who will be attending Gisborne Girls' High School and the Tairawhiti Services Academy in 2020 either as a new enrolment or as a returning student. We are looking forward to a productive and successful year. This letter is to inform you of some important information concerning the start of the school year. If you have any questions that are not answered by this letter please don't hesitate to contact the school. The school office will re-open Friday 17th January from 9:00am to 2:30pm.

A. School Year Commencement

1) Tuesday 28th January: Year 9 and any new enrolments at any level

All Year 9 students and any new enrolments at other levels, along with their whanau, are invited to attend the official powhiri and welcome to the school. As this is the important first event for our Hinetu Programme which involves a collective partnership with whanau and community to foster and embed our school values it is expected that all new students and whanau attend. At this welcome students will meet their form teacher, receive their timetable and visit their form room. A barbeque will be provided, and we hope that all new enrolments will take this opportunity to meet the people who will be their important support network for the new school year. Students are to attend in correct school uniform. Please assemble at the bus bay on Stanley Road at 5:15pm.

2) Wednesday 29th January: Year 9 students and Prefects only

School starts at 8:25am and students are to report their Form Class. Year 9 students are asked to bring a pen, drink bottle, lunch and their swimming gear. School will finish at 2:00pm. The Kaiti buses will be available to take students home at this time; other bus students can remain at school until the country buses depart at their usual time.

3) Wednesday 29th January: Timetable issues Year 11-13 Students only

All 2020 Year 11-13 students will receive an e-mail in the new year outlining their timetable. Only those students who want, or need, to discuss their timetable are to come to the school office between 10am -1.00pm this day. **If no changes are needed then students are not require to attend on this day.**

4) Thursday 30th January: Years 9-11 students and Prefects only

School starts at 8:25am. Years 9-10 students are to report to their Form Class. Year 11 students are to meet in the Hall for assembly. School will finish at 2:00pm. The Kaiti buses will be available to take students home at this time; other bus students can remain at school until the country buses depart at their usual time.

5) Friday 31st January: Years 12 and 13 students only

School starts at 8:25am. Years 12 and 13 students are to report to their Form Class. School will finish at 1:00pm. The Kaiti buses will be available to take students home at this time; other bus students can remain at school until the country buses depart at their usual time.

6) Monday 3rd February: Full school

Lessons commence today and the normal school timetable will operate. The school cafeteria will be open from this day.

B. Uniform

All students are expected to come to school every day in correct uniform. Students must wear the regulation uniform items appropriate to their year level. Included in this mailout is a copy of our Parent Handbook. I draw your attention to the section outlining the uniform requirements, where you will also find the uniform price list.

The uniform shop is open **Friday 17th January and Monday 20th - Friday 24th January from 9:00am - 2:00pm**. The office and uniform shop will be closed **Monday 27th January** for Anniversary Day.

C. Stationery

Stationery lists will be issued to students when they receive their timetable on their first day at school. As the stationery requirements are subject specific it is best to issue the lists once timetables are finalised to avoid purchasing items that may then not be needed. The school does not sell stationery, but the various outlets in town offer good deals throughout the first weeks of school. Our lists are also found on <https://www.myschool.co.nz/Gghs>. Students are requested to have their stationery by week two.

D. Bank Information

Enclosed with this letter is the form to change or set up automatic payments to the school. Many parents find this a very convenient way to cover school expenses. If you would like to set up an automatic payment for 2020 you simply need to complete the details on the form and take it in to your current bank or you can complete this process online. **Please ensure that the student's full name is recorded in the 'Particulars' and 'Reference' part of the form. Please take note that the school can no longer accept cheque payments.**
